- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Consolidated Financial Results of Vodafone Idea Limited (the "Holding Company" or "the Company") and its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as "the Group") and its associate for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 and year to date from April 01, 2025 to September 30, 2025 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
- 2. The Holding Company's Management is responsible for the preparation of the Statement in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34, (Ind AS 34) "Interim Financial Reporting" prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The Statement has been approved by the Holding Company's Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. 6. Material Uncertainty Related to Going Concern

We draw attention to Note 3 to the consolidated financial results, which describes the Group's financial condition as of September 30, 2025, including its debt obligations due for the next 12 months. The Group's financial performance has impacted its ability to generate cash flows that it needs to settle/refinance its liabilities as they fall due. The Group's ability to continue as a going concern is dependent on continued support from DoT on the AGR matter, successfully arranging funding and generation of cash flow from its operations that it needs to settle its liabilities as they fall due. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.

7. The accompanying Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results includes the Group's share of net loss and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.2 million and Rs. 0.5 million for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 and year to date from April 01, 2025 to September 30, 2025 respectively, as considered in the unaudited consolidated financial results in respect of associate, based on its interim financial results which have not been reviewed by any auditor. These unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information have been approved and furnished to us by the Management. Our conclusion in so far as it relates to the affairs of the associate, is based solely on such unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information. According to the information and explanations given to us by the management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group. Our conclusion is not modified with respect of this matter.



Notes

- The above unaudited consolidated financial results of Vodafone Idea Limited, its subsidiaries (the Group), joint venture
 and associate, as reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board, were approved and taken on record by the Board of
 Directors at their meeting held on 10th November, 2025.
- 2. The AGR demands till FY 2019 are part of the four-year moratorium period. Settlement of the AGR liability is subject to disposal of the representations made/to be made by the Company in line with the orders pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this regard.
 - In September 2025, the Company filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court seeking quashing of the additional AGR demands for the period up to FY 2017 raised by DoT and for comprehensive reassessment/reconciliation of all AGR dues including interest and penalty upto said period. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, keeping in view the change in circumstances and the larger public interest, vide its orders dated 27th October, 2025 and 3th November, 2025, has held that the matter falls within the policy domain of the Government of India (GoI) and DoT could reconsider the issue. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has also clarified that DoT could reassess and reconcile all AGR dues including interest and penalty up to the said period. Pending the outcome of such reconsideration/re-assessment by DoT, no effect has been given in these consolidated financial results.
- 3. The Group has incurred a loss of Rs. 121,323 Mn for the six months ended 30th September, 2025 and net worth stands at negative Rs. 824,602 Mn at that date.
 - As at 30th September, 2025, the Group's outstanding debt from banks (including interest accrued but not due) is Rs. 15,421 Mn and Deferred payment obligation (including interest accrued but not due) towards Spectrum which is payable over the years till FY 2044 and AGR which is payable over the years till FY 2031 aggregates to Rs. 2,014,090 Mn.
 - The AGR instalment on which moratorium was availed as per the Telecom Reforms Package 2021, falling due during FY 2026 is Rs.164,280 Mn (subject to reconsideration / re-assessment of AGR dues including Interest and Penalty up to FY 2016 17 by DoT discussed in Note 2 above). Instalments related to deferred payment obligations towards spectrum payable by September 2026 is Rs. 25,581 Mn.
 - Out of the total debt from banks (including interest accrued but not due) of Rs 15,421 Mn, an amount of Rs 14,402 Mn is payable in the next 12 months i.e. by September 2026 with applicable interest. Further an amount of Rs 858 Mn has been reclassified from long-term borrowings to short-term borrowings for not meeting certain covenant clauses under the financial agreements. The Group has exchanged correspondences and continues to be in discussion with the lenders for next steps/waivers.
 - As of date, the Group has met all its debt obligations payable to its lenders / banks and financial institutions along with applicable interest. The Company is in discussion with banks to raise additional funds as required.

The Group's ability to settle the above liabilities is dependent on reconsideration / re-assessment of AGR dues including Interest and Penalty up to FY 2016 - 17 by DoT, fund raise through equity and debt and generation of cash flow from operations. Based on current efforts and recent directions by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Group believes that it would be able to get DoT support, successfully arrange funds and generate cash flow from operations. Accordingly, these consolidated financial results have been prepared on a going concern basis.

4. As at 30th September, 2025, assets include amounts recorded as recoverable from the promoters of erstwhile Vodafone India Limited ("VInL") under the Implementation agreement (IA) executed on 20th March, 2017. Under the IA, the Company can claim the amounts should it discharge part of the AGR dues by 30th June, 2025 ("Last Settlement Date"). Considering the moratorium by the GoI, the AGR dues have not been paid by the Company. The parties have extended the Last Settlement Date till 31st December, 2025. The Company will take necessary steps as required in this regard to realise this amount.



- 5. The Group operates only in one reportable segment i.e. Mobility and hence no separate disclosure is required for Segments.

Notes

- The above unaudited financial results, as reviewed by the Audit Committee of the Board, were approved and taken on record by the Board of Directors at their meeting held on 10th November, 2025.
- 2. The AGR demands till FY 2019 are part of the four-year moratorium period. Settlement of the AGR liability is subject to disposal of the representations made/to be made by the Company in line with the orders pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in this regard.

In September 2025, the Company filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court seeking quashing of the additional AGR demands for the period up to FY 2017 raised by DoT and for comprehensive reassessment/reconciliation of all AGR dues including interest and penalty upto said period. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, keeping in view the change in circumstances and the larger public interest, vide its orders dated 27th October, 2025 and 3th November, 2025, has held that the matter falls within the policy domain of the Government of India (GoI) and DoT could reconsider the issue. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has also clarified that DoT could re-assess and reconcile all AGR dues including interest and penalty up to the said period. Pending the outcome of such reconsideration/re-assessment by DoT, no effect has been given in these financial results.

- 3. The Company has incurred a loss of Rs. 122,168 Mn for the six months ended 30th September, 2025 and net worth stands at negative Rs. 820,801 Mn at that date.
 - As at 30th September, 2025, the Company's outstanding debt from banks (including interest accrued but not due) is Rs. 15,421 Mn and Deferred payment obligation (including interest accrued but not due) towards Spectrum which is payable over the years till FY 2044 and AGR which is payable over the years till FY 2031 aggregates to Rs. 2,014,090 Mn.
 - The AGR instalment on which moratorium was availed as per the Telecom Reforms Package 2021, falling due during FY 2026 is Rs. 164,280 Mn (subject to reconsideration / re-assessment of AGR dues including Interest and Penalty up to FY 2016 17 by DoT discussed in Note 2 above). Instalments related to deferred payment obligations towards spectrum payable by September 2026 is Rs. 25,581 Mn.
 - Out of the total debt from banks (including interest accrued but not due) of Rs 15,421 Mn, an amount of Rs 14,402 Mn is payable in the next 12 months i.e. by September 2026 with applicable interest. Further an amount of Rs 858 Mn has been reclassified from long-term borrowings to short-term borrowings for not meeting certain covenant clauses under the financial agreements. The Company has exchanged correspondences and continues to be in discussion with the lenders for next steps/waivers.
 - As of date, the Company has met all its debt obligations payable to its lenders / banks and financial institutions along with applicable interest. The Company is in discussion with banks to raise additional funds as required.

The Company's ability to settle the above liabilities is dependent on reconsideration / re-assessment of AGR dues including Interest and Penalty up to FY 2016 - 17 by DoT, fund raise through equity and debt and generation of cash flow from operations. Based on current efforts and recent directions by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Company believes that it would be able to get DoT support, successfully arrange funds and generate cash flow from operations. Accordingly, these financial results have been prepared on a going concern basis.

4. As at 30th September, 2025, assets include amounts recorded as recoverable from the promoters of erstwhile Vodafone India Limited ("VInL") under the Implementation agreement (IA) executed on 20th March, 2017. Under the IA, the Company can claim the amounts should it discharge part of the AGR dues by 30th June, 2025 ("Last Settlement Date"). Considering the moratorium by the GoI, the AGR dues have not been paid by the Company. The parties have extended the Last Settlement Date till 31st December, 2025. The Company will take necessary steps as required in this regard to realise this amount.





- 5. The Company operates only in one reportable segment i.e. Mobility and hence no separate disclosure is required for Segments.
